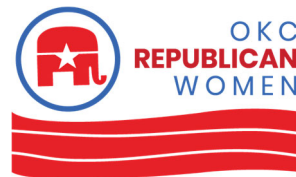


Stephanie Bice, State Senator District 22, is a primary candidate for the 5th District House of Representatives.

In a recent interview, the couple unveiled plans for an event called the "Governor's Prayer Breakfast." The event will be **February 18th at 7:30 AM** at the National Cowboy and Western Heritage Museum. Admiral Barry C. Black, the first black and Seventh-day Adventist chaplain to the U.S. Senate, will be keynote speaker.

The governor said the event is open to people of all faiths. He said he would like to see Oklahomans unite to pray for their communities, state and leaders. It will occur close to the convening of the Oklahoma Legislature in February.

"We're really excited to have this inaugural prayer breakfast to kind of start the year out and also to kick off the legislative session next year," he said.

Individuals interested in attending the prayer breakfast are encouraged to buy tickets by purchasing a table, meaning they may register for a table of 10 and then fill that table with family, friends and guests of their choice.

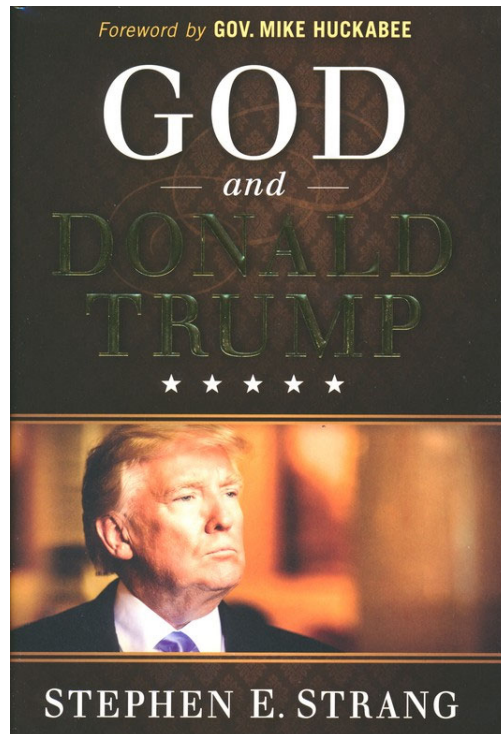
Cost: \$1,000 per table of 10. Simulcast sites also are planned.

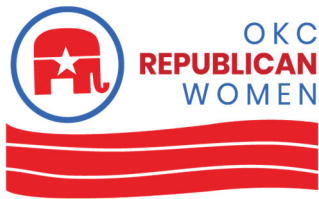

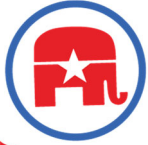
